


Career Readiness Talk with Han Chiang University College of Communication: Employer Expectations, Resume Writing & Interview Skills

Basic Stop-Motion Animation Workshop will continue to another level and raise interest within the youth!







"Ketupat" is a traditional dish in the Malay community. It is essentially rice cakes in diamond-shaped pouch made of palm leaves. In Malaysia, ketupat is often made, served, and displayed during Hari Raya! The Penang Youth Development Corporation (PYDC) took the initiative to promote the culture through our Art In Motion: Ketupat-Weaving mini workshops during the Butterworth Miao Hui Celebration for Chap Goh Mei 2023!

A lot of visitors, especially the youth, were interested to learn ketupat-weaving and they did a very good job in making ketupat for the first time! We also added sweets in the ribbon ketupats and distributed it to young children to put a smile on their faces.

Kolam is a traditional form of art involving drawing and colouring with coloured rice or flour. Kolam varies in design, some of which are considered auspicious to Hindus, such as animals and floral patterns. The process of making the kolam is also related to meditation, as it takes a lot of patience, calmness, and concentration, especially while filling the design layer by layer with coloured rice.

The Penang Youth Development Corporation (PYDC) took the initiative to promote the cultural heritage through our "Art in Motion: Kolam-Crafting" workshop during the Butterworth Miao Hui Celebration for Chap Goh Mei 2023!
